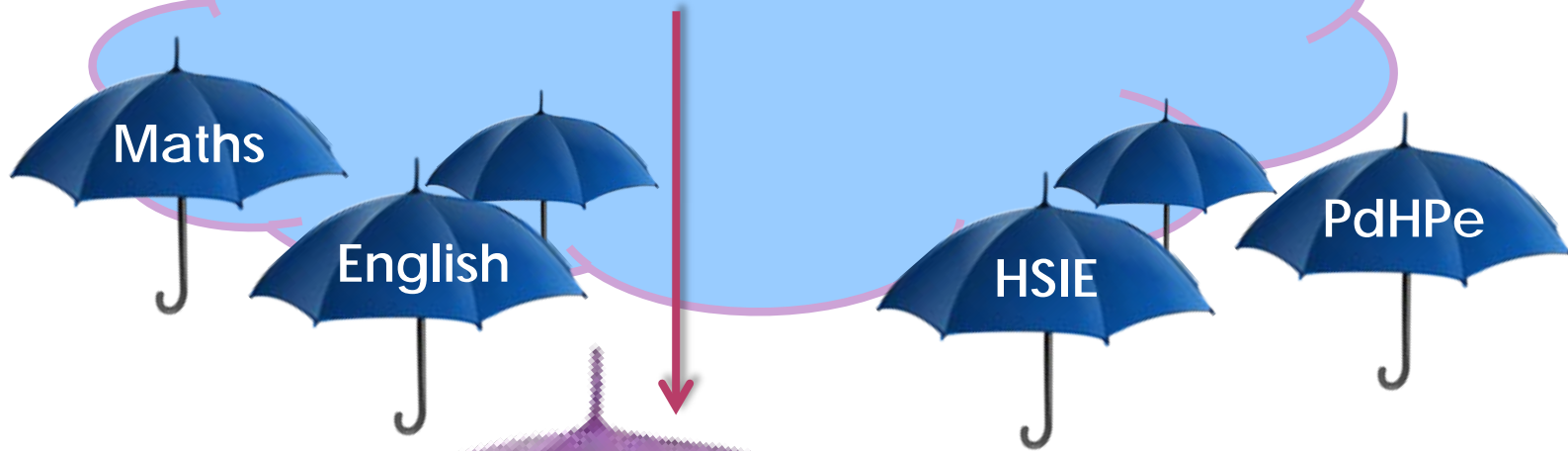


# MUSIC @ STANMORE

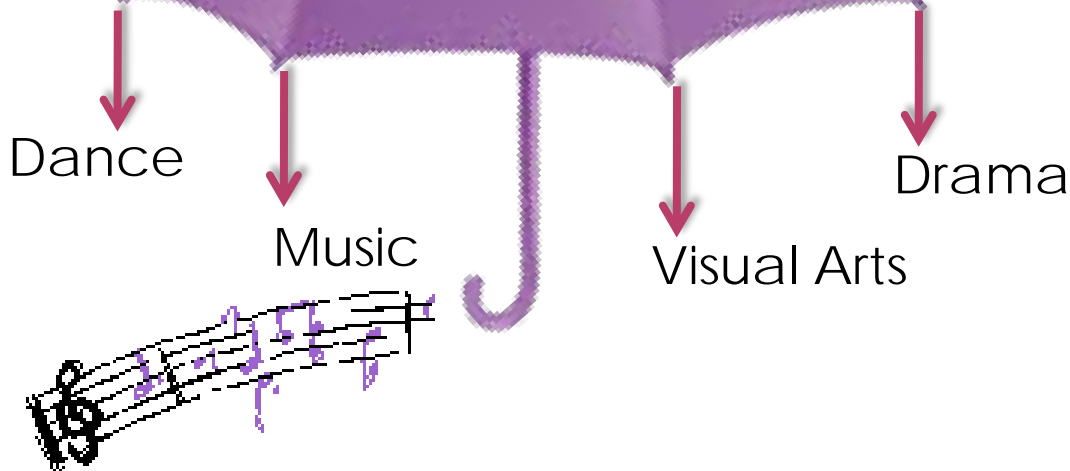

Weekly rehearsals.

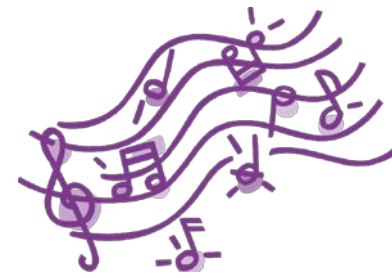
- Caters for a range of ages and abilities.
